Petition to ¹ Vacate the Otto-Pfeiffer Ditch.

To the Board of County Commissioners, Ottawa, County, Ohio:

The undersigned hereby petition your honorable body to ¹ Vacate the Otto-Pfeiffer Ditch.

On the course hereinafter set forth.

The petitioner(s) hereby propose the construction of the improvement is necessary, will benefit the petitioner(s), and will be conducive to the public welfare.

The following is the course and termini of said proposed improvement, to-wit:

Commencing: (As described in the original petition and transcribed accordingly) On the south side of the Duff-Washa Road in Section 5, Carroll Township and 152' east of the drive into the property of Chas. Arndt; thence east along the south side of the Duff-Washa Road to the Fremont-Oak Harbor Northern Road known as State Route No. 19; thence south along the west side of the said State Route 19, through Sections 5 & 8, to the dredge cut and there to terminate, being in all a distance of approximately 1.25 miles.

All costs of engineering, construction, and future maintenance will be assessed to the benefiting parcels of land, except under Section 6131.31 of the Revised Code.

The following is the nature of the work petitioned for: Vacating the Otto-Pfeiffer Ditch.

filed a petition with the Clerk of the County Commissioners of Ottawa County, Ohio, making application to the County Commissioners to ² Vacate Otto-Pfeiffer Ditch Petitioned for by Anna Dupler and others, The following being the course and termini of said proposed improvement, to-wit:

Commencing: (As described in the original petition and transcribed accordingly) On the south side of the Duff-Washa Road in Section 5, Carroll Township and 152' east of the drive into the property of Chas. Arndt; thence east along the south side of the Duff-Washa Road to the Fremont-Oak Harbor Northern Road known as State Route No. 19; thence south along the west side of the said State Route 19, through Sections 5 & 8, to the dredge cut and there to terminate, being in all a distance of approximately 1.25 miles.

Now, if the said Anna Dupler will pay the cost of notices, plus any other incidental expenses, except the costs incurred by the Engineer in making his preliminary reports, if the prayer of the petition is not granted or if the petition is for any cause dismissed, unless the Board of County Commissioners decides to pay the Engineer's costs from this Bond in accordance with Section 6131.09 of the Revised Code; then this obligation shall be void; otherwise it shall be and remain in full force and virtue in law.
